- **Abstract:** In his study on philosophical thanatology, *Todesmetaphren*, T. H. Macho analyses what he calls the “paradox of the corps”. We are witnesses of a fundamental ontological change: the existential-ontological structure of the Dasein (being there/presence) turns into an object.
