Les constructions en *adverbe que p* en français Essai de caractérisation sémantique d'une matrice lexicale productive

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- **Abstract:** This study aims at accounting for a very common construction in Modern French, namely *adverbe que p*, *heureusement que p* being the most famous example, given the impossibility of the “symmetric” combination *malheureusement que p*. In fact, a thorough examination of the various linguistic properties that can be shown up reveals that beyond the same surface structure three different constructions can be identified. One of them, corresponding to *heureusement que p*, rests upon a *lexical pattern*, that is a combination of both a syntactic and a semantic invariant. Several examples—in diachrony as well as in synchrony—are discussed.
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
