

- Abstract: Some paratexts written by male authors and editors during the Italian Renaissance could be intended to give counsel
 on women's conduct. Advice was offered directly, in prefaces, for instance, that suggested how works by Boccaccio should be
 read, or less explicitly, especially through letters of dedication addressed to women. These women could be portrayed as
 embodiments of virtues and connoisseurs of culture, and thus as living paragons of good conduct that female readers could
 attempt to emulate.
