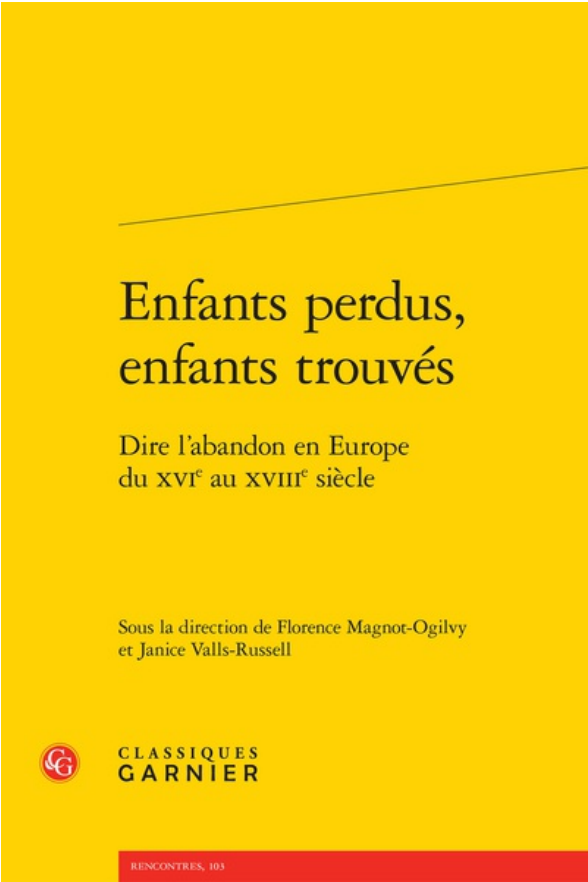

- **Abstract:** The attitude of the ruling class in the Republic of Genoa towards abandoned children is revealed through its charitable interaction with the Hospital of *Pammatone*. The Ricordi manuscript written by the Genoan patrician Andrea Spinola (1562 ?-1631) – of which we analyse the unpublished part – shows that the growing number of exposed children was becoming a burden for the Republic. Sending these children to colonise Corsica could be considered a way of introducing a hierarchy between the misery of legitimate and illegitimate paupers.
