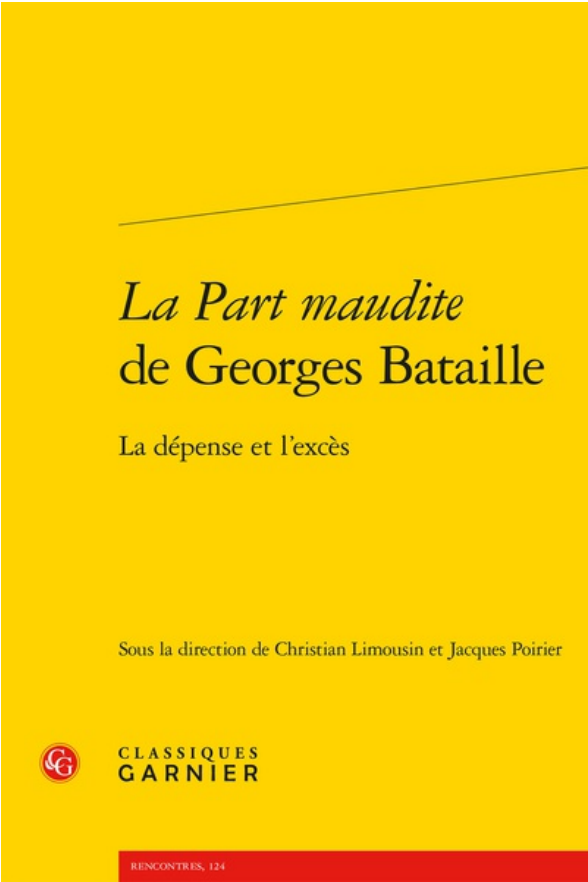


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La Part maudite Un « Non Savoir » économique ?
